Kagoshima Prefectural Iroha Junior High School

Iroha JHS is the first public night junior high school in Kagoshima, opening in April 2025. Classes will be held in the evening; the only difference from Daytime Junior High Schools.



School Mission:

Iroha JHS provides a place to learn actively and respects everyone's goal.

Our Vision:

1 Respect for others

Students will lead a safe and secure school life, respecting others.

2 Enhanced guidance based on the situation of each student

Students' situations and ideas will be respected. School will support students, taking each of their individual needs into consideration.

3 Learning Engagement

Students' motivation and needs will be also upheld.

Qualification Requirements

Residents of Kagoshima Prefecture who meet one or more of the following criteria are eligible for admission:

- People who were unable to attend school due to a war or other external reasons
- People who graduated from junior high school without sufficient education due to not attending school
- Foreign residents who did not receive compulsory education in their home country or in Japan



Admission and Graduation

- There is no entrance exam. To ensure easy enrollment, each student will take an interview and submit their enrollment documents. Students can start school as a second- or third-year student, depending on their learning history.
- Upon completing all courses, students can obtain a junior high school graduation qualification. Students can stay enrolled for up to six years, depending on the situation.



School Life

- Students attend school five days a week, from Monday to Friday.
- School starts at 5:25 p.m. and Ends at 9 p.m.
--- Please let us know if you cannot come to the class due to work conditions, etc.
- There are four classes a day, with each class being 40 minutes.
- Students can eat meals before class starts or after the second period.
- There are two semesters as well as summer and winter holidays.

Content of Study

- Students will study the same subjects as in daytime junior high schools.
- Teachers are licensed junior high school teachers.
- If necessary, students will study Japanese or elementary school level content, while studying junior high school level.
- Each student can borrow a tablet device in order to use for schooling.

Step 2

We will conduct an interview about your reasons to enroll and your past learning history.
